


## The WRAG September 2012

Well it's just a few days to the GWR rally and we hope you've already got your tickets, because the PayPal facility has now closed.




So you will have to now pay on the gate the miserly sum of £12 for the weekend, or £5 for a day pass. Hope to see you all there folk.
