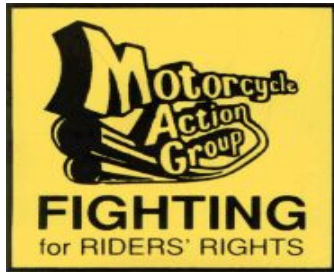

So why not pop up to Blackpool and have your say, but don't forget to take your valid membership card or you won't get in.

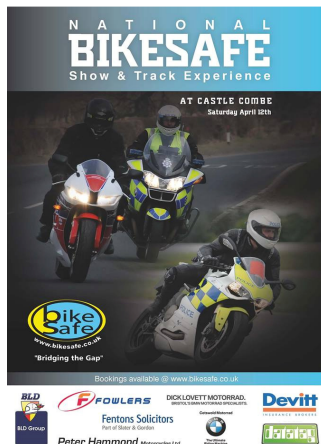
#### GWR Rally



Plans for the GWR rally is going along fine, bands are being booked, and tickets are going well.

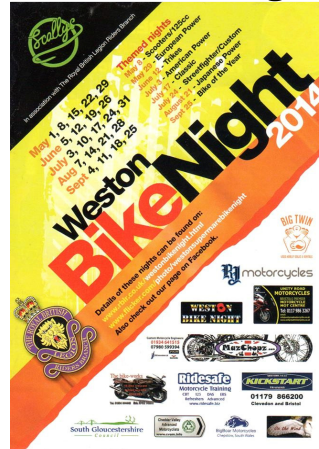
The special patches for the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the GWR rally have arrived and look great, so if you want one get pre-booked or you'll lose out!
